## PROJECT CONTACT

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**The Conservation Delivery Grant** is given to the SWCD for the general administration and operation of the district. These administrative and operational costs include paying for the cost of: Insurances, Dues/Fees, and Supervisors' Compensation and Expenses, Employee wages and expenses.

All funds are expected to be expended as of June 30, 2015.

The Easement Delivery Grant is given to the SWCD to help market the Reinvest in Minnesota (RIM), the Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program (CREP) and the Wetland Reserve Program/Reinvest in Minnesota (WRP/RIM) programs; attend training sessions; conduct screening committee meetings; process easements; perform on-site investigations and surveys; monitor easements and conduct spot-checks; and perform courthouse searches and finalize easements.

All funds are expected to be expended by June 30, 2015.

**The Farm Bill Assistance Grant** is given to the SWCD to hire staff to increase landowner participation in the conservation provisions of the Federal Farm Bill which increase the amount of native grasses and wetlands on the landscape to enhance water quality, reduce soil erosion, and increase fish & wildlife habitat.
